



## **ONE - DIGIT NUMBERS**

→ Some numbers are formed with one digit. Those numbers are called one - digit numbers.

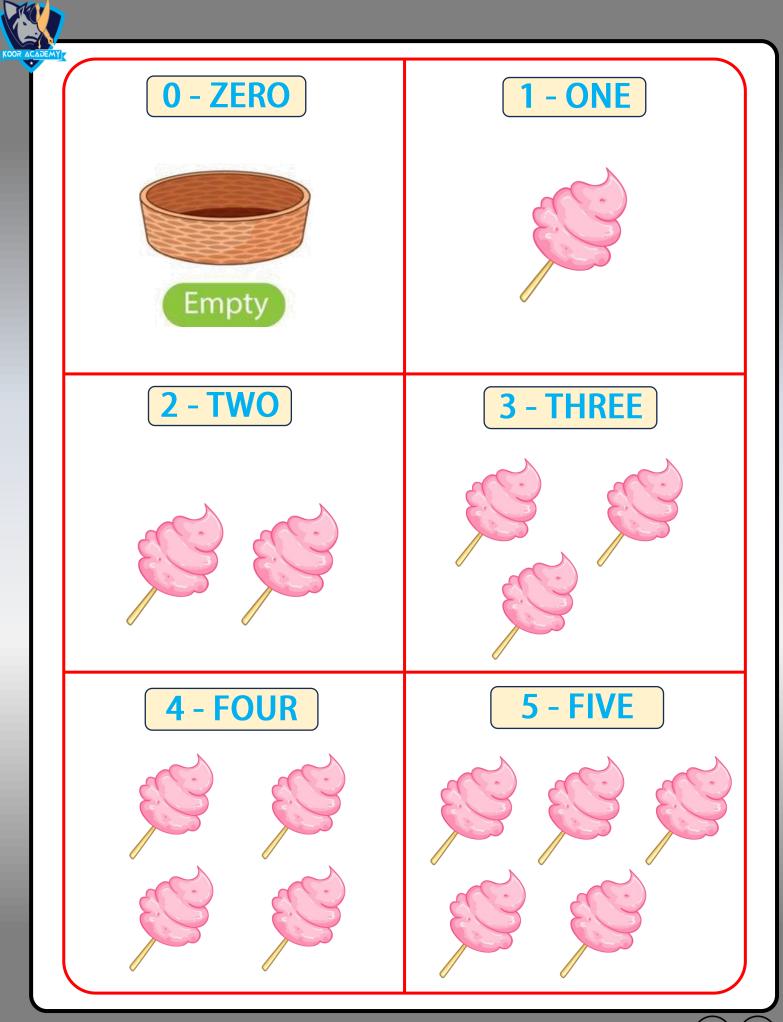
→ 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 are called
one - digit numbers.

→ Because those numbers have only one numeral.

→ One - digit numbers start from 0 and end with 9.

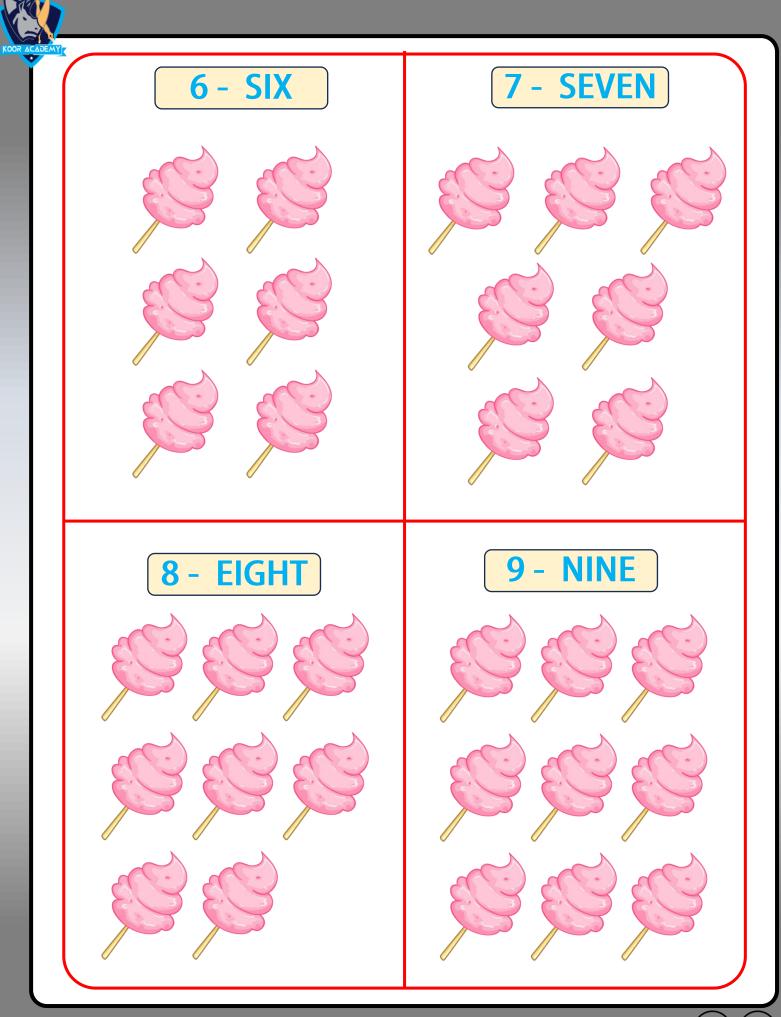
 $\rightarrow$  The smallest one - digit number is 0.

 $\rightarrow$  The **biggest** one - digit number is 9.
