ONE - DIGIT NUMBERS

→ Some numbers are formed with **one digit**. Those numbers are called **one - digit numbers**.

→ **0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9** are called **one - digit numbers**.

→ Because those numbers have only **one numeral**.

→ One - digit numbers **start from 0** and **end with 9**.

→ The **smallest** one - digit number is **0**.

→ The **biggest** one - digit number is **9**.
