## Capacity:

The Capacity is used for measuring the volume of a liquid.

## The amount of liquid that any container

can hold is called its capacity.

Two types of capacity measurement:

Metric measurement

* Customary measurement


## Metric Measurement

The standard units to measure capacity are litres and millilitres.

Millilitre ( cl ) :
Millilitre is denoted by the letters ml .
A millilitre is a unit to measure very small
quantities of liquids.
Example : cough syrup.

## Litre ( $\ell$ ):

Litre is denoted by the letter $\boldsymbol{l}$.
A litre measures liquids like juice, milk,
water, and so on.
