Measurement of Capacity

Capacity:

The Capacity is used for measuring the volume of a liquid.

The amount of liquid that any container can hold is called its **capacity**.

Two types of **capacity** measurement:

- ❖ Metric measurement
- ❖ Customary measurement

Metric measurement

Metric Measurement

The standard units to measure capacity are litres and millilitres.

Millilitre (*ml*):

Millilitre is denoted by the letters *ml*.

A millilitre is a unit to measure very small quantities of liquids.

Example : cough syrup.



Litre (*l*):

Litre is denoted by the letter *l*.

A litre measures liquids like juice, milk, water, and so on.
