Measurement of Capacity

Capacity:

The Capacity is used for measuring the volume of a liquid.

The amount of liquid that any container can hold is called its capacity.

Two types of capacity measurement:

- Metric measurement
- Customary measurement



Metric measurement





Metric Measurement

The standard units to measure capacity are litres and millilitres.

Millilitre (ml):

Millilitre is denoted by the letters *ml*.

A millilitre is a unit to measure very small quantities of liquids.

Example: cough syrup.



Litre (ℓ):

Litre is denoted by the letter ℓ .

A litre measures liquids like juice, milk,

water, and so on.
