



CONCEPT OF ZERO




ZERO





- > Zero denotes that **no amount** or **no objects** or **no values.**
- ➤ It's not worth itself but it can change the value of other numbers.
- \triangleright The symbol of zero is '0'.




> 0 Fish represents there is no fish in the fish tank.





There are 3 birds on this tree



A bird flew to somewhere. Then, there are 2 birds.










Then, there is **only one** bird on this tree.



That last bird also flew. Now, there is no Bird on the tree.

That means 0 birds.



EXAMPLE

Here, we see an another example.



Yellow Tulip



Red Tulip



There are 3 butterflies on the red Tulips.

There are 0 butterflies on the yellow Tulips.

That means no butterflies are there.





EXAMPLE

Here, we have 3 baskets and some strawberries.



3 Strawberries



1 Strawberry



0 Strawberry (Empty)

EXAMPLE



This boy has 3 balloons

All three balloons have flew away from him



Now, the boy has **0** balloons
