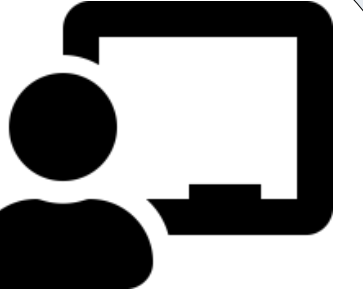




# ONE – DIGIT NUMBERS





# ONE - DIGIT NUMBERS

- Some numbers are formed with **one digit**. Those numbers are called **one - digit numbers**.
- **0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9** are called **one - digit numbers**.
- Because those numbers have only **one numeral**.
- One - digit numbers **start from 0** and **end with 9**.
- The **smallest** one - digit number is **0**.
- The **biggest** one - digit number is **9**.



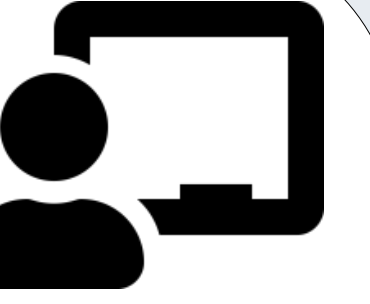

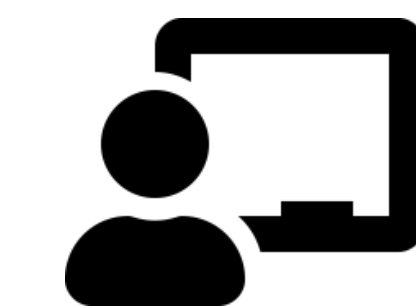

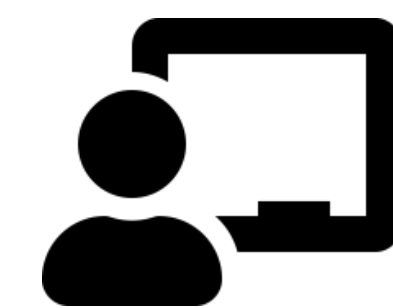
