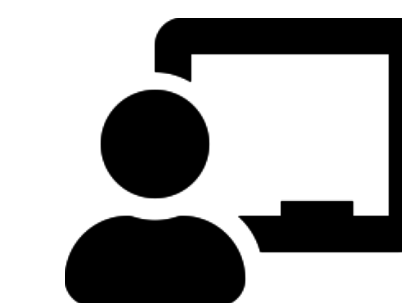


# Before, After and between

# Before, After and between



## Before

Earlier in time, position, or rank.

Example:

8 comes before 9.



Eight



Nine



Ten

## After

Later in time, position, or rank.

Example:

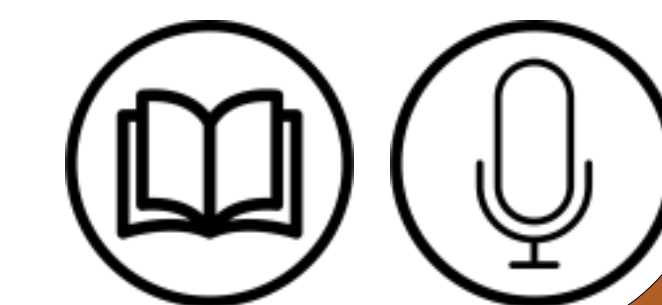
10 comes after 9.

## Between

Separating two things.

Example:

9 is in between 8 and 10.



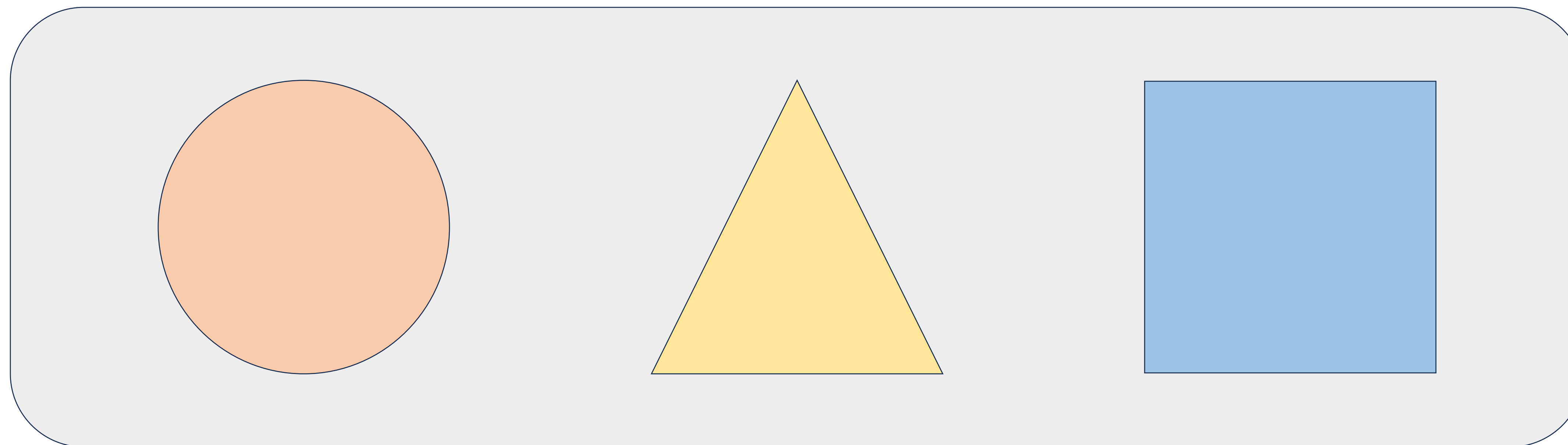


**August** comes **before** September.

**October** comes **after** September.

**September** is in **between** August and October.





**Circle** placed **before** the triangle.

**Square** placed **after** the triangle.

**Triangle** placed in **between** the circle and the square.





**Spring** is the season **before** the Summer.

**Autumn** is the season **after** the Summer.

**Summer** is the season **between** the Spring and the Fall.



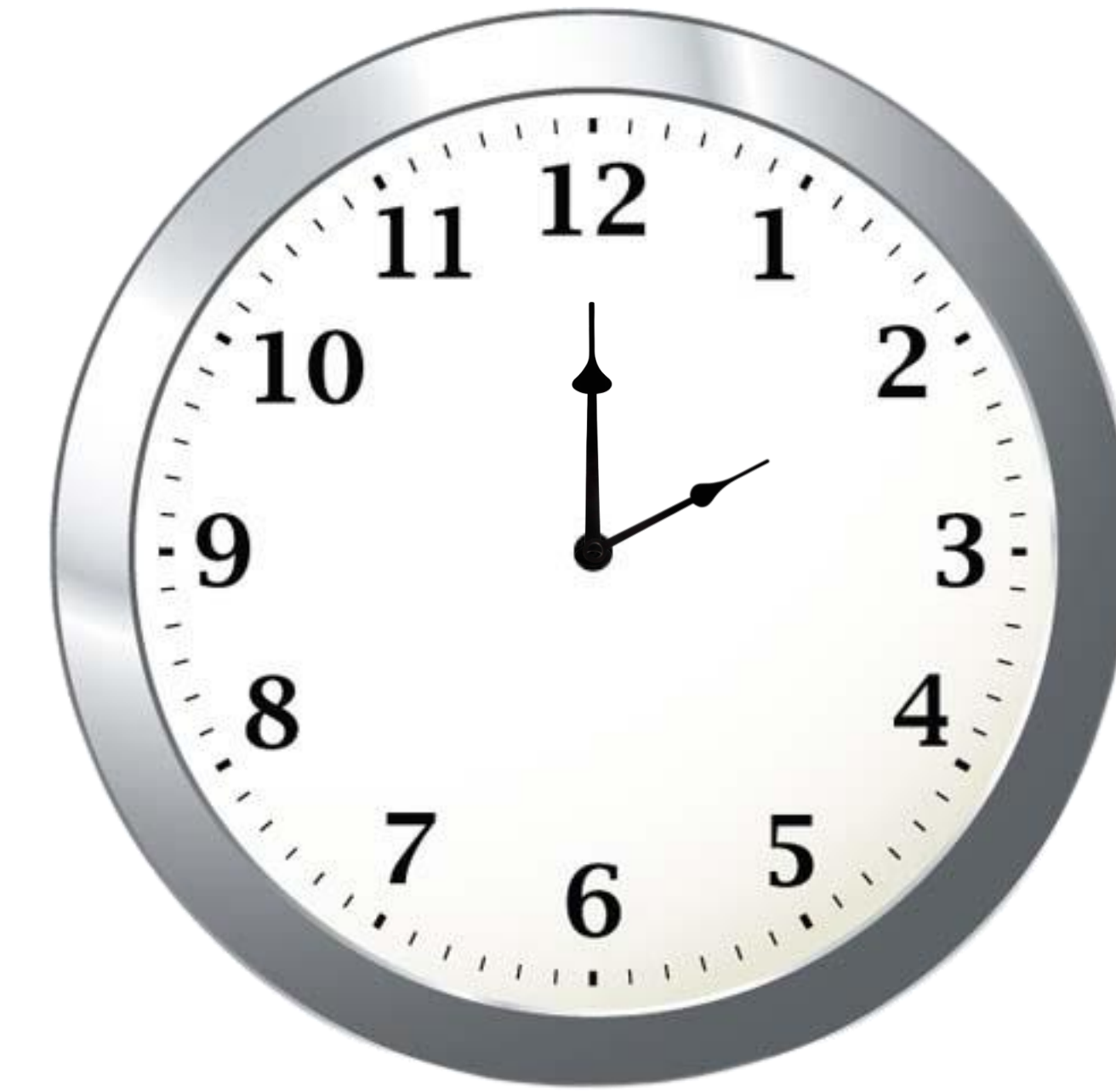
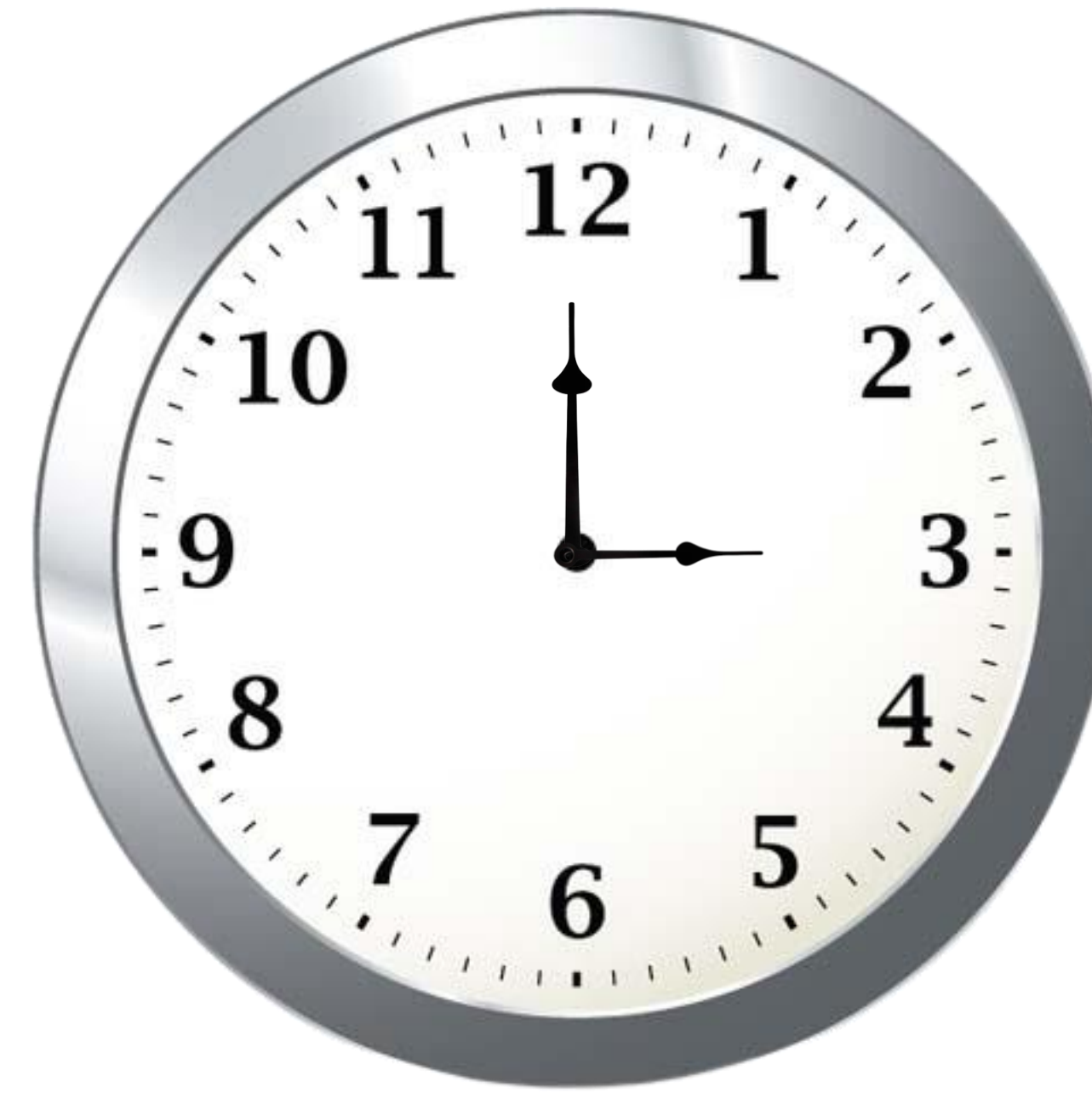
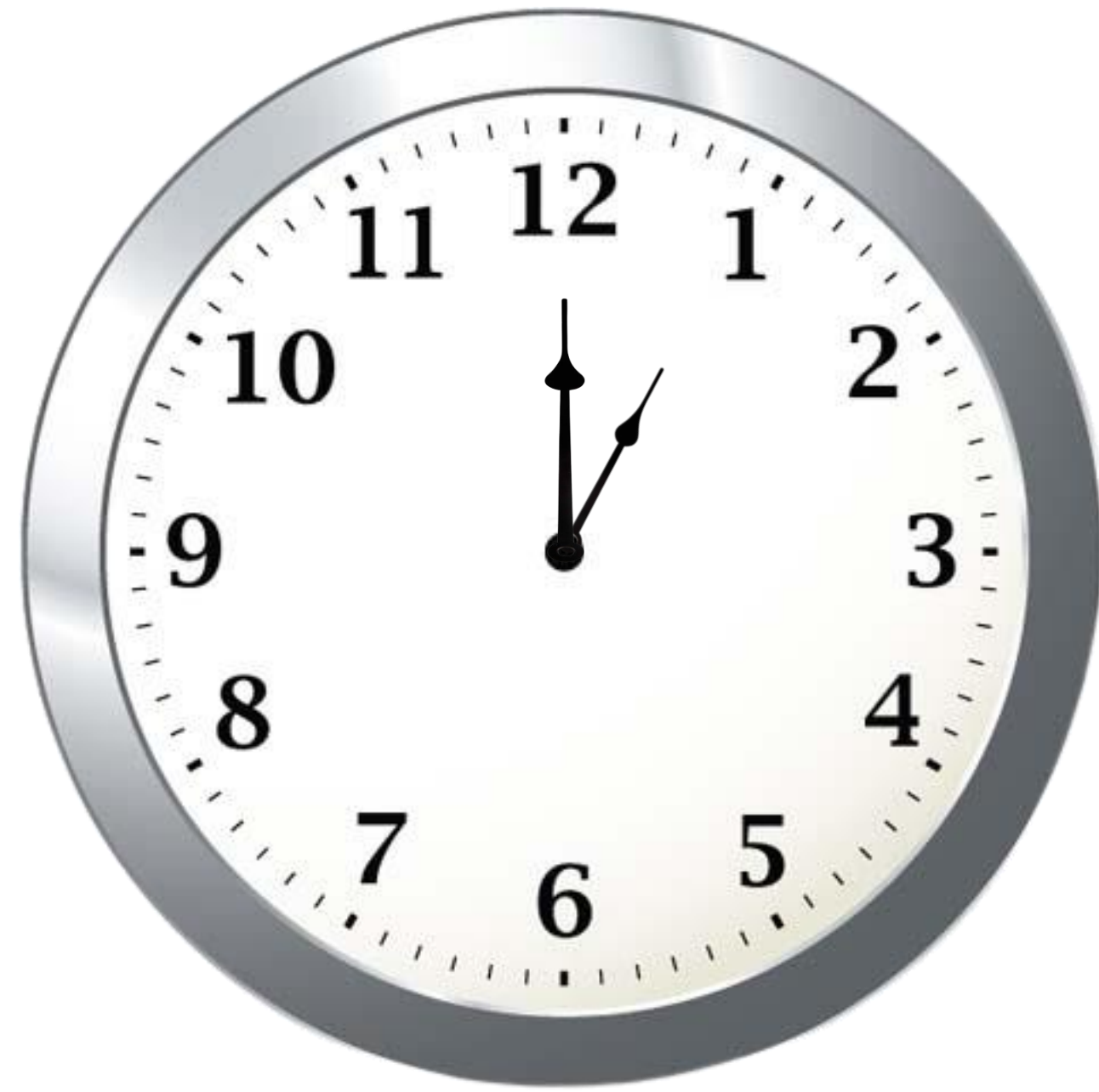


In numerical order

85 comes before 86.

87 comes after 86.

86 falls between 85 and 87



1 o'clock is one hour before 2 o'clock

3 o'clock is one hour after 2 o'clock

The hour hand moves from 1 to 2 between 1 o'clock and 2 o'clock.
