## Date

We use ordinal numbers when giving a date

- My friend birthday is on **5<sup>th</sup>**
- New year is celebrated on **1<sup>st</sup>** of January
- **22<sup>nd</sup>** of March is a sun day
- Neil Armstrong is died on **25<sup>th</sup>** of August

## Centuries

We use ordinal numbers to express the century that something happened

- Shakespeare was born in the **sixteenth** century
- We are living in **twenty first** century
- India is Independence on middle of **twentieth** century





## Floors

We use ordinal numbers to express the number of a floor in a building.

- Our office is on the **9<sup>th</sup>** floor
- My sister apartment is on the **21<sup>st</sup>** floor

## Celebration

We use ordinal numbers when we want to say the total number of years we are celebrating.

- My parents **25<sup>th</sup>** wedding anniversary celebrated on last Monday.
- Coming Friday is my brother's **33<sup>rd</sup>** birthday.

We use ordinal numbers when we want to show the order or position of something in a sequence

- Our Indian hockey team got a **third** prize
- Donald Trump is the **forty fifth** president of U.S
- Holy see is a **one hundred and ninety fifth** country in the world
