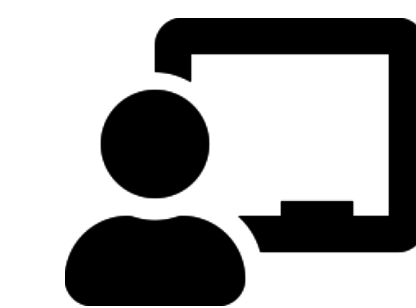

There are 2 common ways to tell time.

- Hour First then the Minutes
- Minutes First then the Hour

Hour First then the Minutes

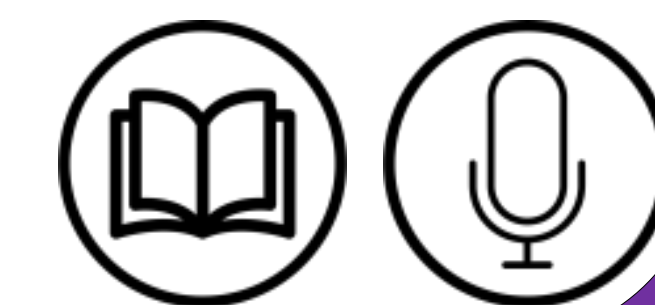
Say the hour First then the Minutes (hour + minutes)

08:30 - Eight Thirty

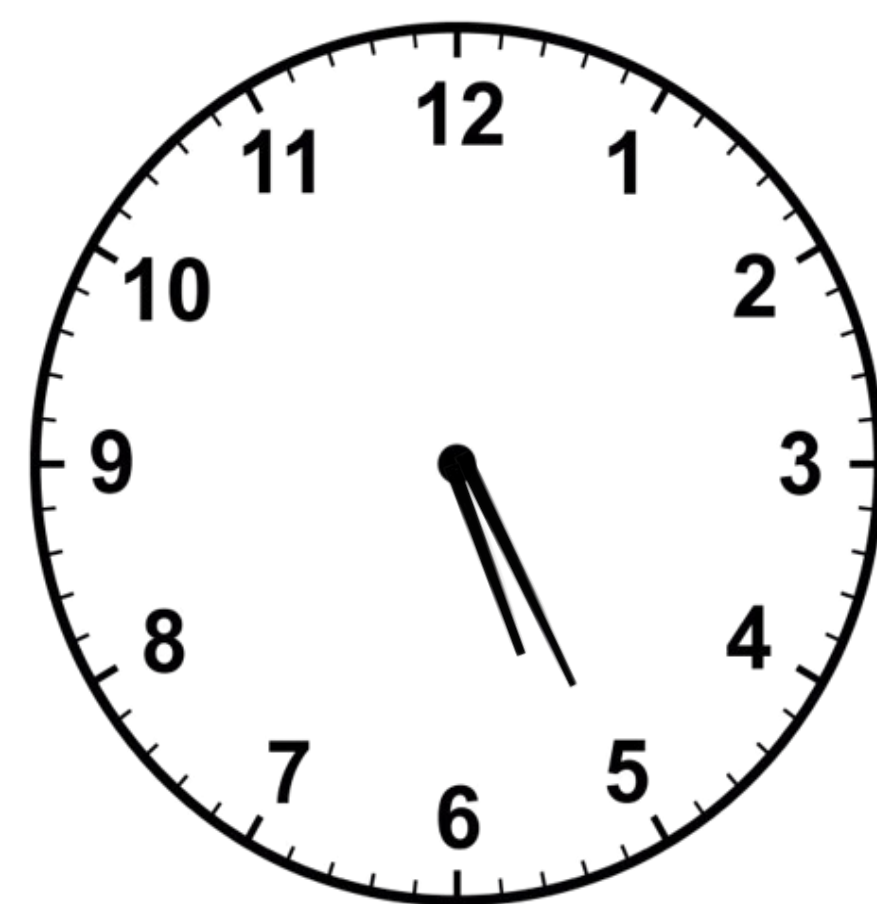
04:45 - Four Forty Five

01:23 - One Twenty Three

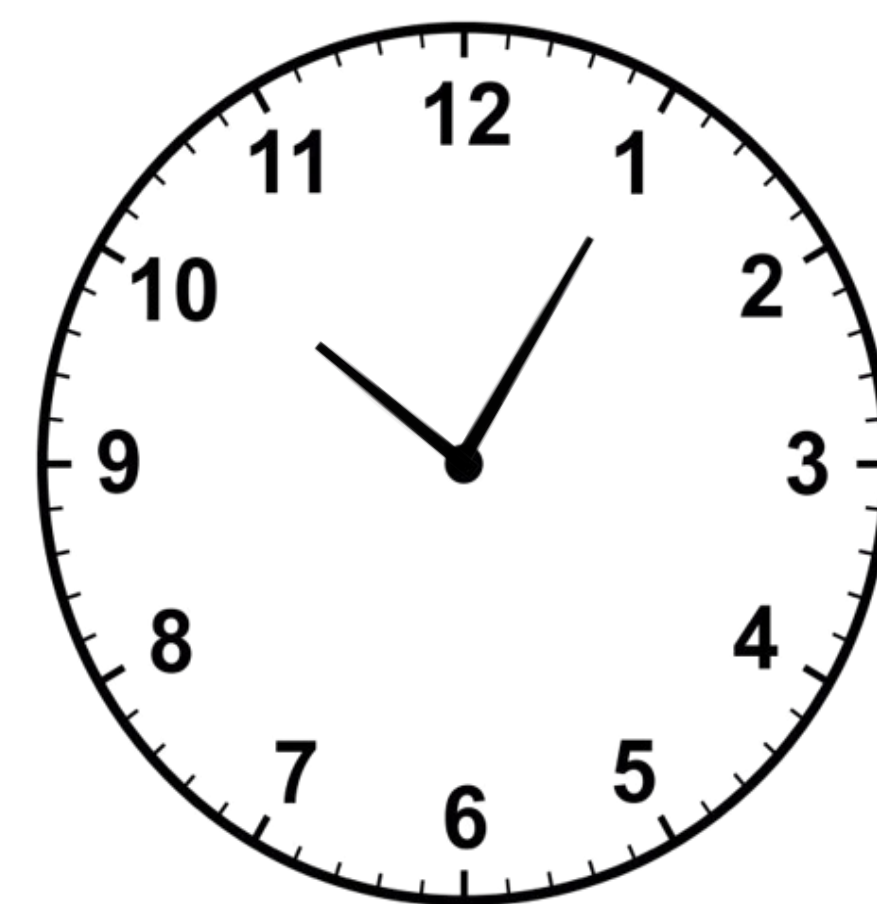
11:02 - Eleven O-Two (Eleven Oh Two)



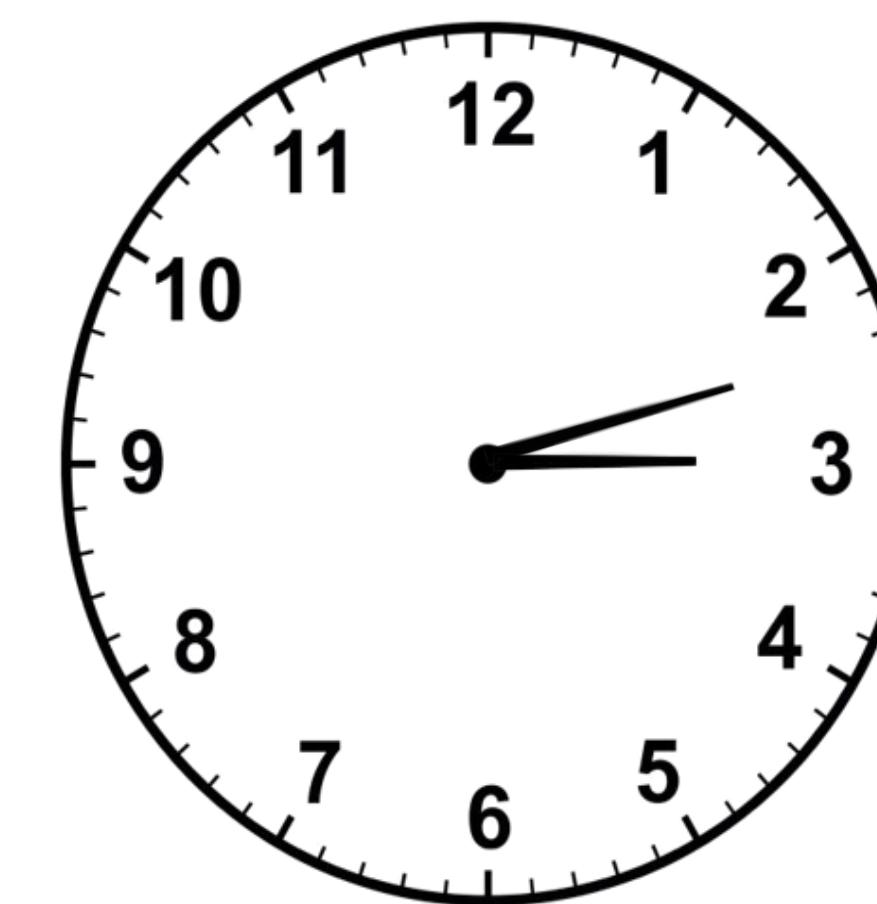

Minutes First then the Hour

Say the Minutes First then the Hours (minutes + past/to + hours)

For minutes 1-30, we use past after the minutes

For minutes 31-59, we use to after the minutes

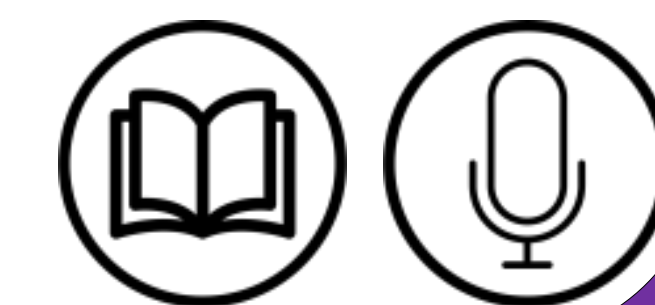
4:40 - It's twenty to Four

1:10 - It's ten past one

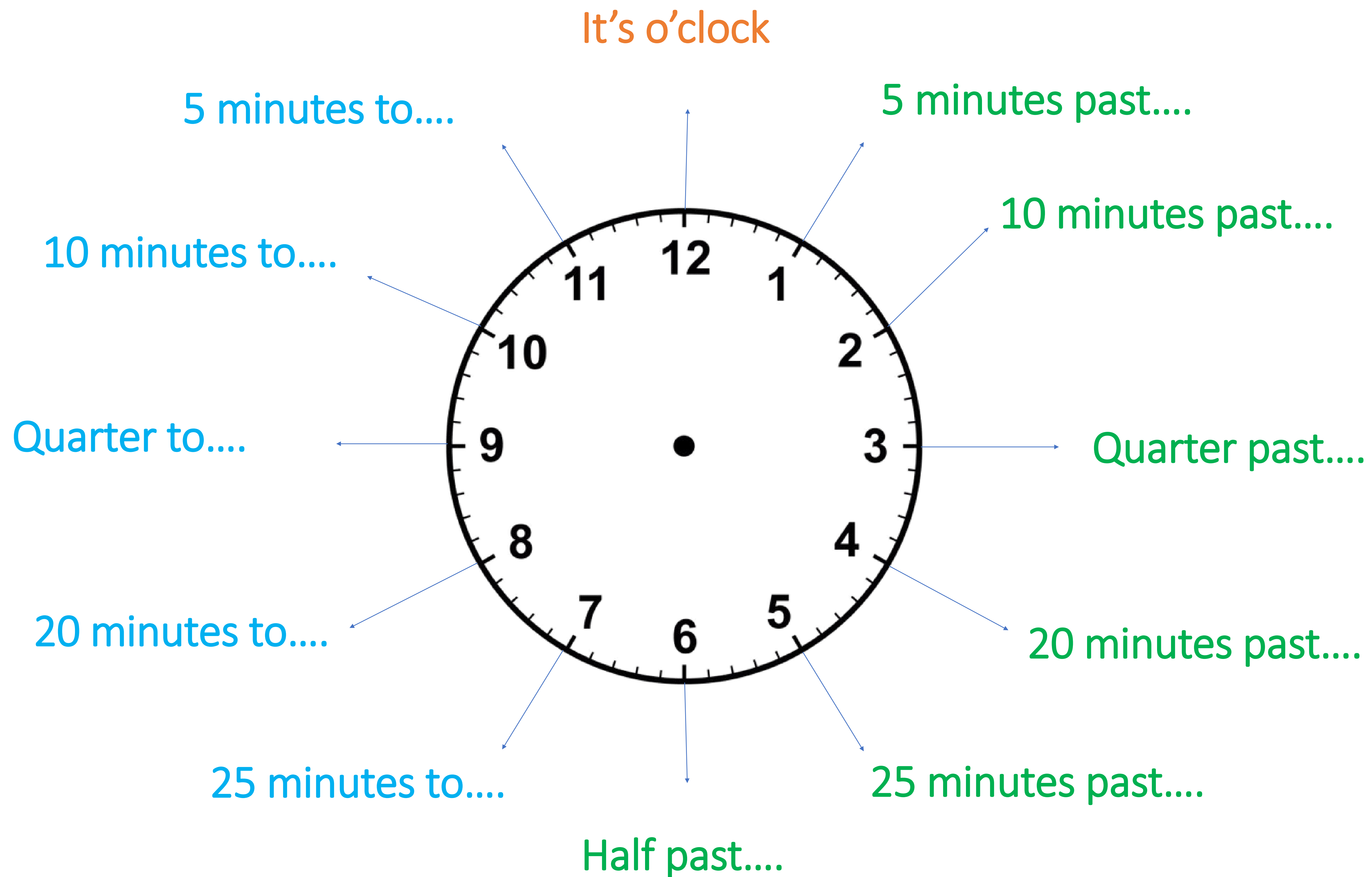
3:18 - It's eighteen past Three

7:55 - It's five to Seven

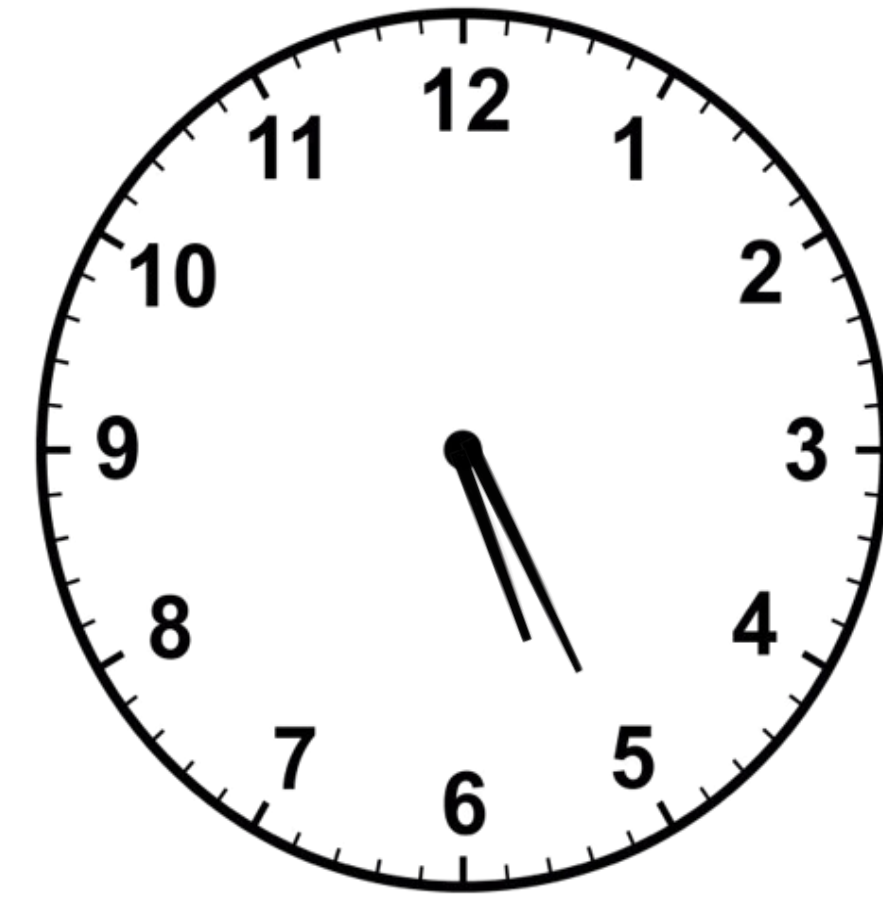
9:59 - It's one to 10



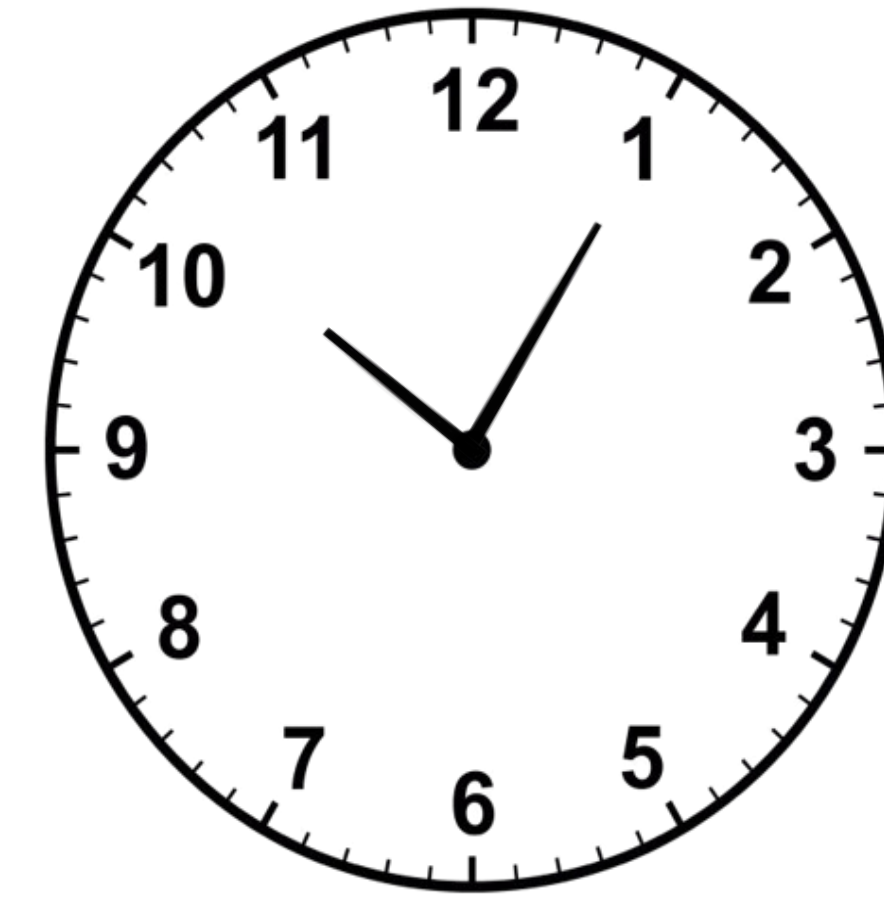
Lets know about inside numbers of clock



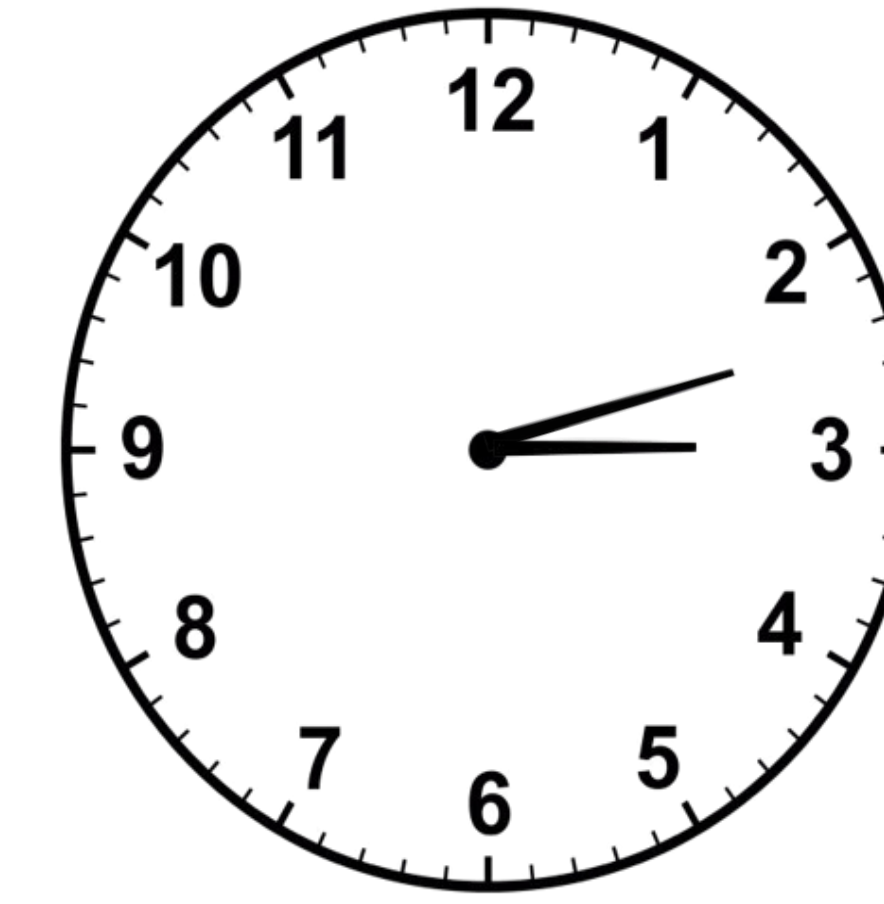

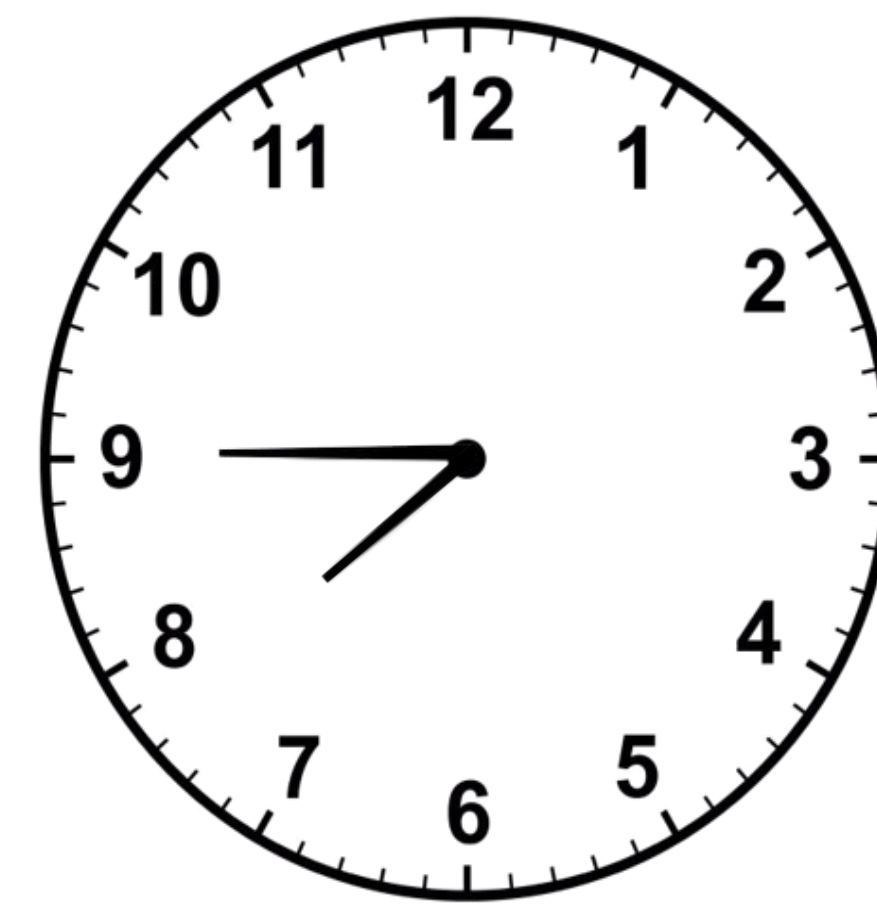
Twenty Five past Five



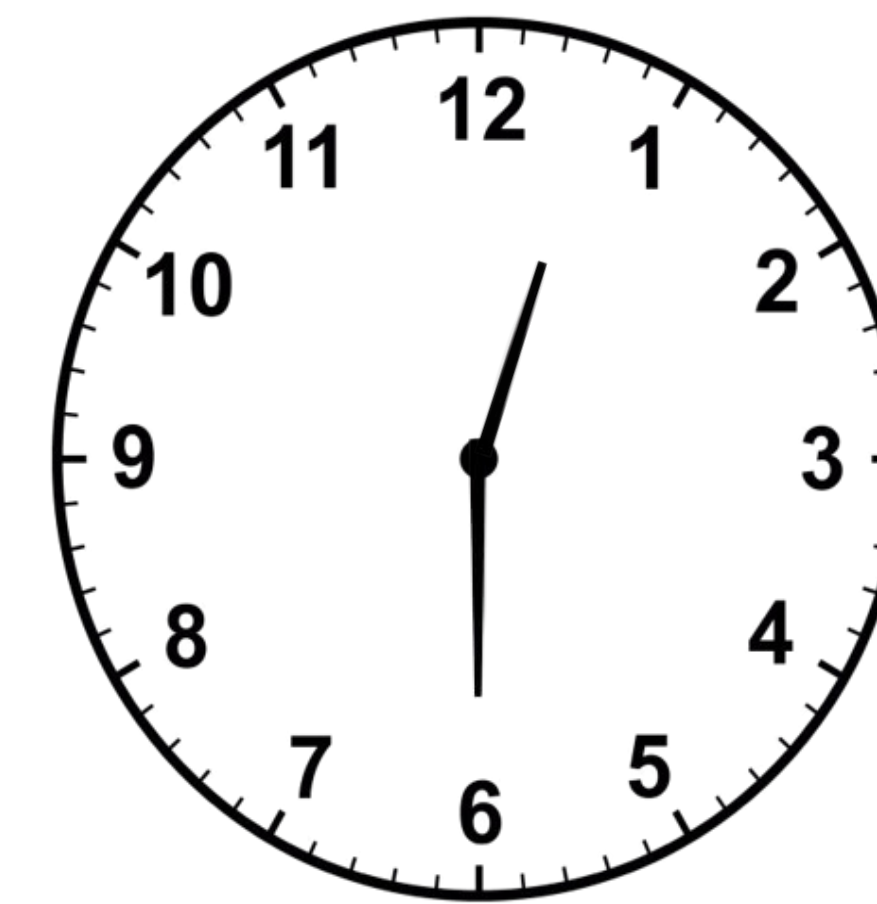
Five past Ten

O'clock

Used to specify the hour when telling the time.

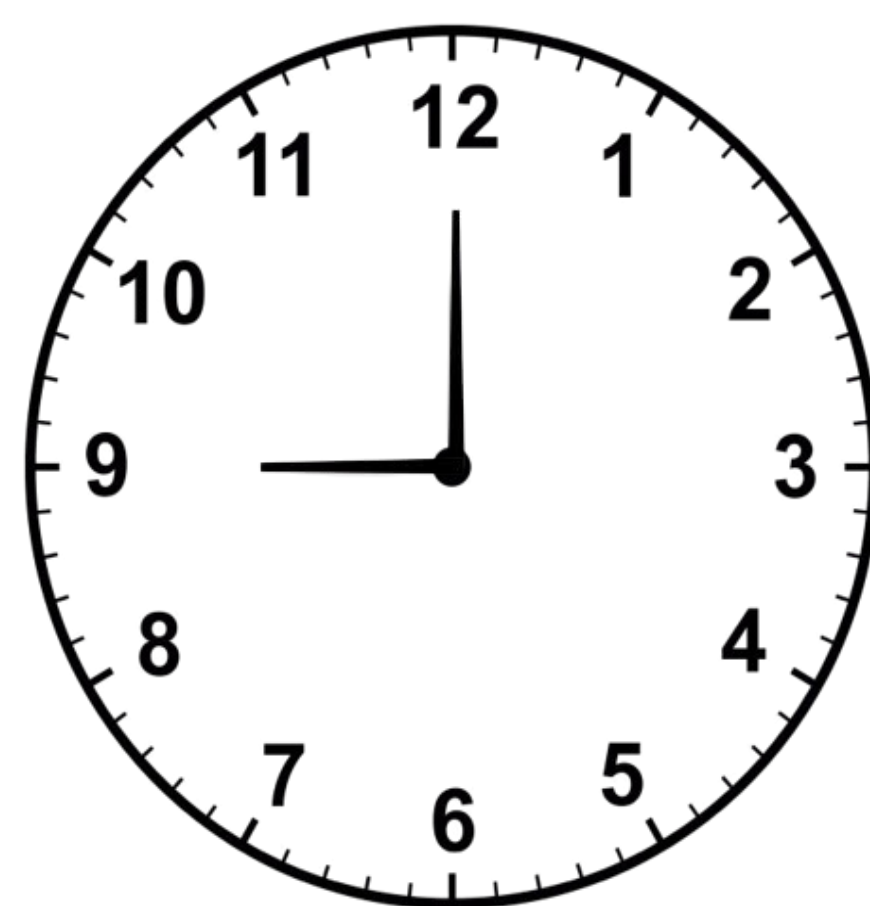
We use o'clock when there are NO minutes.

'of the clock' is shortened to "o' clock"

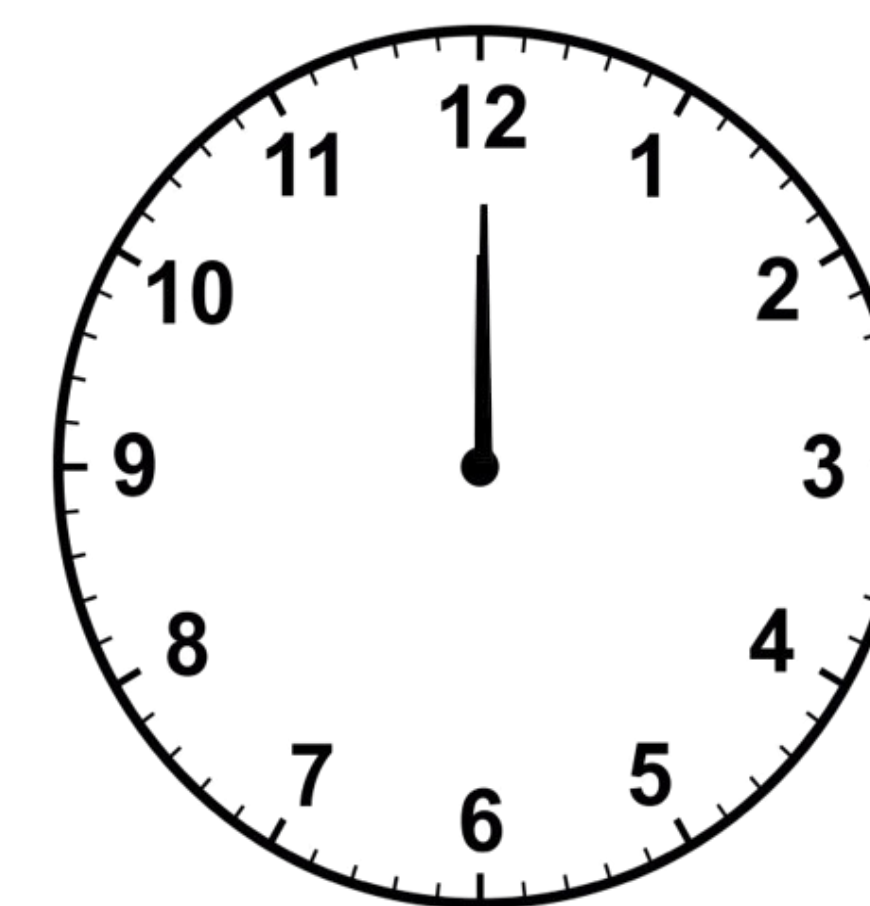
Hours + o' clock
