We know the words minutes, seconds, hours. Let's see how much time it means.






Seconds



Very short durations are expressed in seconds which is called smallest unit of time.


Activities that we can do in seconds




Blinking eyes

Activities that we can do in hours







Analogue clock





Hours hand



This is the shortest and thickest hand, and it tells us the hours. It takes 12 hours to make one complete revolution around the clock face.

Minutes hand

This is the medium-length hand, and it tells us the minutes. It takes 60 minutes for it to make one complete revolution around the clock face.

Seconds hand


This is the thinnest and fastest hand, and it tells us the seconds. It takes 60 seconds for it to make one complete revolution around the clock face.








Digital clock

60 seconds = 1 Minute

1 Minute

60 Minutes = 1 Hour

Units of time

1 Minute = 60 seconds

1 Hour = 60 minutes

60 Minutes = 1 hour

60 Seconds = 1 minute
