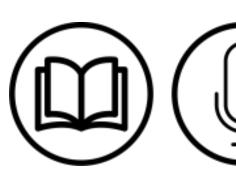


Text alignment





Superscript

❖ A superscript is a character that is set slightly above the normal line of type.

It is usually smaller than the rest of the text.

Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press Ctrl + Shift + +

Subscript

A subscript t is a character that is set slightly Below the normal line of type.

It is usually smaller than the rest of the text.

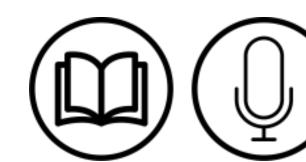
❖Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press Ctrl + =

Growing & Shrinking Font

Grow Font is used to increase the size of the font. Shrink font is

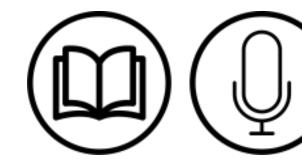
used to decrease font size.
