# Superscript

- ❖ A superscript is a character that is set slightly above the normal line of type.
- ❖ It is usually smaller than the rest of the text.
- ❖ Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press **Ctrl + Shift + +**

# Subscript

- ❖ A subscript is a character that is set slightly below the normal line of type.
- ❖ It is usually smaller than the rest of the text.
- ❖ Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press **Ctrl + =**

Basket ball	Basket <b>ball</b>
Throw ball	throw <b>ball</b>





# Growing & Shrinking Font

- ❖ Grow Font is used to increase the size of the font. Shrink font is used to decrease font size.





**Growing font:** Hi Hi Hi Hi Hi Hi Hi

**Shrinking font:** Hi Hi Hi Hi Hi Hi Hi
