# Bold B

- ❖ Bold is used to highlight the text and capture the reader's attention
- ❖ Move the Cursor to the Mini toolbar and click Bold
- ❖ If you want to unbold or remove bold from bolded text, you would repeat the same above steps.





# Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press Ctrl + B

## Examples

Unbold text	<b>Bold text</b>
Attribute	<b>Attribute</b>
News & Media	<b>News &amp; Media</b>





# Underline U

- ❖ An underline is a more or less horizontal line immediately below a portion of writing
- ❖ It also called an underscore.





# Underline U

❖ Move the Cursor to the Mini toolbar and click

Underline

❖ If you want to remove Underline repeat the same

above steps





# Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press Ctrl + U

## Examples

Attribute	<u>Attribute</u>
News & Media	<u>News &amp; Media</u>





# Italic *I*

- ❖ Italic type is a cursive font based on a stylised form of calligraphic handwriting.
- ❖ They are used to emphasize or distinguish words.





# Italic *I*

- ❖ Move the Cursor to the Mini toolbar and click Underline.
- ❖ If you want to remove italic style repeat the same above steps.







# Shortcut Key - Select Text and Press Ctrl + I

Normal text	<i>Italicized text</i>
Attribute	<i>Attribute</i>
News & Media	<i>News &amp; Media</i>
