## ZERO

$>$ Zero means nothing.
$>$ Zero denotes that no amount or no objects or no values.
$>$ It's not worth itself but it can change the value of other numbers.
$>$ The symbol of zero is ' 0 '

There are $\mathbf{3}$ birds on this tree.



That last bird also flew. Now, There is no bird on the tree.

That means $\mathbf{0}$ birds
