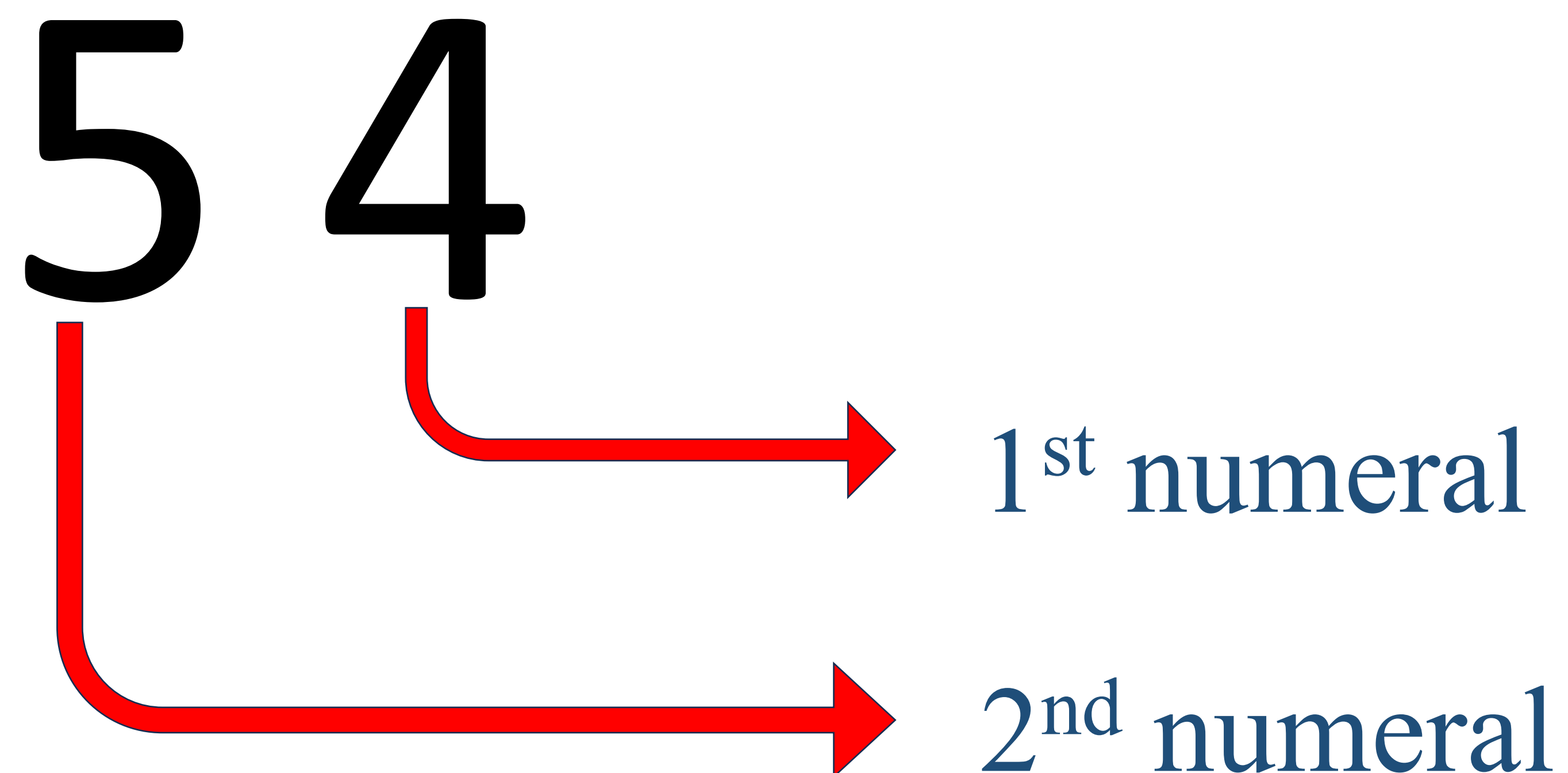
# TWO - DIGIT NUMBERS

- Some numbers are formed with **two digits**. Those numbers are called **two - digit numbers**.
- **10, 11, 12, 13,....., 97, 98, 99** are called **two - digit numbers**.
- Because those numbers have **two numerals**.
- Two - digit numbers **start from 10** and **end with 99**.
- The **smallest** two - digit number is **10**.
- The **biggest** two - digit number is **99**.

# TWO – DIGIT NUMBER

For example,

54 is a two - digit number.



54 has 2 numerals. So, 54 is a two - digit number.
