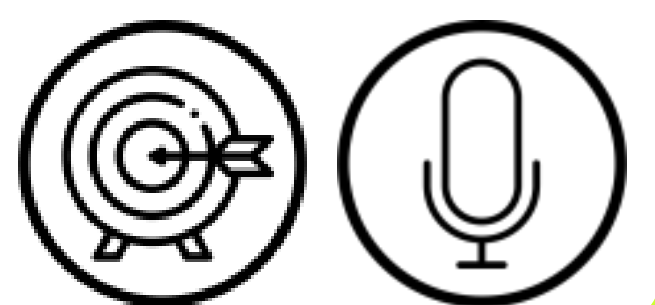




Definition of ordinal numbers

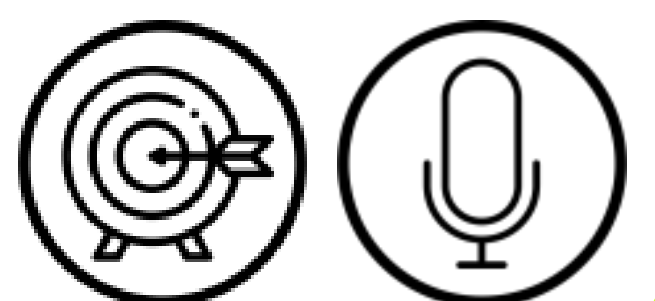


Definition 1

An ordinal number tells us the position of something in a list.

Definition 2

A number that is used to show the position of some on or something in a series.

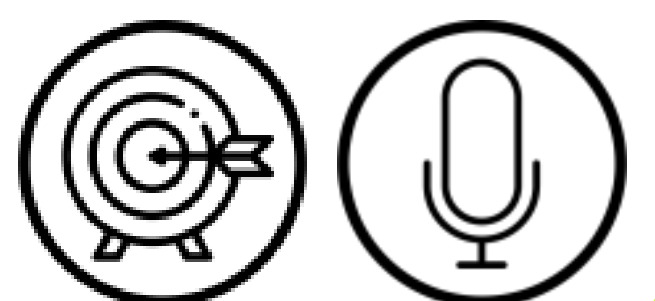


Definition 3

An ordinal number is the numerical position of an object.

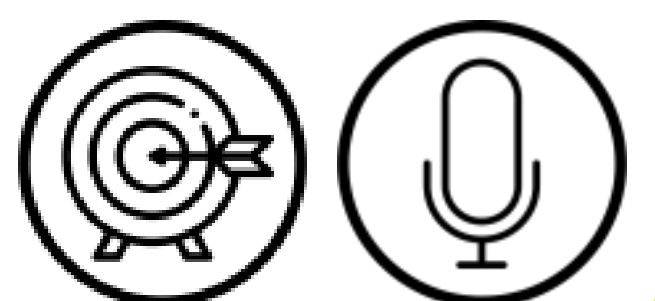
Definition 4

An ordinal number refers to a number that indicates the position or order of things or objects.



Ordinal numbers

Ordinal numbers attribute to a position or place of an object's standing. They are written as **first, second, third** or in numerals, as **1st, 2nd, and 3rd**, etc. Normally, they are indicated by “**th**,” or sometimes by “**nd**” or “**st**”.



Common use of ordinal numbers

- He got **third** prize
- The **first** three series were wonderful to watch
- A boy and his twin brothers remembering their **eleventh** birthday
