



## Read the statement and solve the problem

- 1) There are 5 bunches of balloons at a party. Each bunch has 3 balloons. How many balloons are there at the party?

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Total number of bunches} = 5 \\ \text{No. of balloons in a bunch} = 3 \\ \hline 15 \end{array}$$

So, totally 15 balloons are there in the party.

- 2) There are 4 plates of cookies. Each plate has 15 cookies. How many cookies are there in total?

- 3) There are 20 books on each shelf. There are 15 shelves in the library. How many books are in the library?





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- 4) Jessica makes 2 bracelets. She puts 5 beads on each bracelet. How many beads does she use in total?
- 5) There are 3 vases of flowers. Each vase has 20 flowers. How many flowers are there in total?
- 6) There are 18 crayons in each box. There are 15 boxes in the drawer. How many crayons are in the drawer?
