2) Maya starts with 8 ounces of play dough. She uses 3 ounces to make a snowman. How much play dough does she have left?

Solution: - = **ounces**



3) Sarah has a 4-pounds cake. She eats 2 pounds. How much cake is left?

Solution: - = **pounds**



4) Two playful hippopotamuses splash in the mud. One weights 6 tons, and the other weighs 3 tons. How much heavier is the bigger hippo?

Solution: - = **tons**



5) Two majestic whales swim side-by-side. One weighs a whopping 99 tons, and the other weighs 80 tons. How much lighter is the smaller whale?

Solution: - = **tons**
